**Item#1- Adopt Ordinance # 8 of 2020- 2020-2021 Proposed Budget- Junkin**

The following Ordinance was introduced by Councilperson Junkin at the regular meeting of the Winnfield Council held on June 9, 2020, and is presented for adoption by Councilperson Junkin at the special scheduled meeting of the Mayor and City Council held June 23, 2020, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 8 of 2020

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE 2020-2021 BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF WINNFIELD, LOUISIANA, TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS, AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREFOR.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winnfield, Louisiana, that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Winnfield, Louisiana, is hereby amended to provide that the budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021, is hereby adopted as follows:

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winnfield, Winn Parish, Louisiana that this ordinance is deemed severable and should any part or portion hereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the remainder of the ordinance which can be enforced without regard to such invalid or unconstitutional part or portion shall remain in full force and effect.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this ordinance shall be effective upon publication hereof as provided by law and expiration of all legal delays required by law.

**Item #1- 911 Signs Rates- Phillips**

Councilperson Phillips called for a motion to approve the rate of ten dollars for the purchase of 911 signs for local residence who have not put their own 911 sign up. The signs will be wood, 5x12 in size, red or black background with 3 ½ inch numbers. Deadline to have signs posted is August 1, 2020. If residence do not have 911 signs posted by August 1, 2020 the City will put up sign at cost to the property owner and add cost to utility bills. Sign orders can be placed at City Hall. Chief Montgomery recommends that property owners with long driveways off the road or highway that signs be put visible from the road.

On motion by Councilperson Phillips, duly seconded by Councilperson Junkin, after no discussion or no public comment, the 911 signs rates were approved by unanimous vote.
