

The following Ordinance was introduced by Councilperson Junkin at the scheduled meeting of the Winnfield City Council held on March 12, 2019, and is presented for adoption by Councilperson Junkin at the regularly scheduled meeting of the Winnfield City Council held April 9, 2019, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 3 of 2019

AN ORDINANCE TO ADD SECTION 56(E) AND 56(F) TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WINNFIELD, LOUISIANA, TO PROVIDE FOR PAID HOLIDAYS FOR FULL TIME CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF WINNFIELD, LOUISIANA, AND TO PROVIDE FOR COMPENSATION THEREFOR, TO PROVIDE FOR ANY RELATED MATTERS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council for the City of Winnfield, Louisiana that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Winnfield is hereby amended to add Section 56(e) and 56(f) to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Winnfield to provide as follows.

SECTION 56 (e).

That all full time Civil Service employees of the City of Winnfield shall observe the following holidays:

New Year's Day
Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
Easter
Memorial Day
4th of July
Labor Day
Veterans Day
Thanksgiving Day
Day after Thanksgiving
Christmas Eve
Christmas Day

SECTION 56 (f).

All full time civil service employees of the City of Winnfield Police Department and Fire Department shall be compensated at a double-time rate of pay if scheduled and working on the holidays set forth above. Any full time civil service employee of the City of Winnfield Police Department seeking to have a schedule change on holidays must have the approval of the Chief of Police or Fire Chief as may be applicable.

REPEALER

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Winnfield, Winn Parish, Louisiana, that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Winnfield, Winn Parish, Louisiana that this ordinance is deemed severable and accordingly, should any part or portion hereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the rest and remainder of the ordinance which can be enforced without regard to such invalid or unconstitutional part or portion shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be effective on publication hereof and the expiration of the required legal delays. The above Ordinance was introduced on March 12, 2019. A hearing on the above Ordinance was held on April 9, 2019, at a regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winnfield, Louisiana, and thereafter the vote thereon was recorded as follows, to-wit:
